Notice of Intention to Install a Traffic Calming Measure in High Street, Buckden

Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to install a priority narrowing with kerb build-out and separated cycle bypass on the east side of the road (traffic travelling southwards off the A1 to give way) on High Street at a point 15 metres north of St Hugh's Road.

This is part of a scheme to reduce traffic speeds and give priority to more active modes of travel.
