Cambridgeshire County Council (B1514 Buckden Road, Brampton and B1514 Brampton Road, Buckden) (30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) Order 202-

Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of this Order will be to extend the existing 30mph speed limit on B1514 Buckden Road, Brampton by 202m; introduce a new 40mph speed limit from the new 30mph limit for 400m; and introduce a new 50mph speed limit for the remaining length of B1514 Buckden Road/ Brampton Road up to the existing 50mph speed limit which starts at both the A1 northbound and southbound slip roads at Buckden.

Notice of Intention to Install a Signalised Pedestrian Crossing on B1514 Buckden Road, Brampton

Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to install a signalised pedestrian/cycle crossing on B1514 Buckden Road, Brampton at a point 52m south-west of its junction with Farendon Road. The controlled area, including zig-zag markings, of the proposed crossing will cover an overall length of approximately 40m.
