important information - Highway Work

Dear Resident/Occupier

Greener, safer, and better - quality journeys

Notice of upcoming highway works – High Street - Buckden - Footway Improvement Works

We are doing essential work in your area to improve the roads, pavements, and drains. To help you plan around this, we want to share more details with you.

What work will we be doing?

We will be resurfacing the footways on High Street Buckden, up until Church Street. This process involves reconstructing the upper layers of the surface, including any necessary repairs to kerbs or path edges.

When will the work take place?

The work is scheduled to take place from Monday, 13 January 2025, up to Friday 7th February 2025, between the hours of 07:30 and 17:30 on working days only.

Will the road be closed?

Yes, the work will be carried out in three phases.

Phase 3: Closure on high street from Mayfield to Church Street.

For 1 and 2; we will implement a single lane closure and people are expected to follow the diversion route northbound or southbound.

In the areas where the footway is closed, an alternative pathway will be provided to pedestrians. Please refer to the diversion plans for more information.

What does this mean for you?

- We kindly ask **drivers not to park on the footway, kerbs, or verges during the construction period**, as this may impede progress and pose a risk of damage to vehicles.
- Please **ensure that the footpath outside your property is free from overhanging plants, hedgerows, potted plants, or any movable items**. Our ground team will trim back any vegetation encroaching on the highway boundary as necessary to perform this work.
- Access for residents will be maintained throughout the duration of the project, although there may be some delays as you navigate through the traffic management system.

- Please be aware that the work may produce some noise, and we apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. Whenever feasible, we will schedule particularly noisy tasks for the beginning of the work shift to minimise disruption, recognising that everyone's routine may vary.

Will the schedule change?

We will make every effort to deliver the work in the scheduled period. Sometimes however, certain factors, such as weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances, may necessitate a rescheduling on short notice. We will strive to address any challenges that arise and will inform you of any changes whenever feasible.

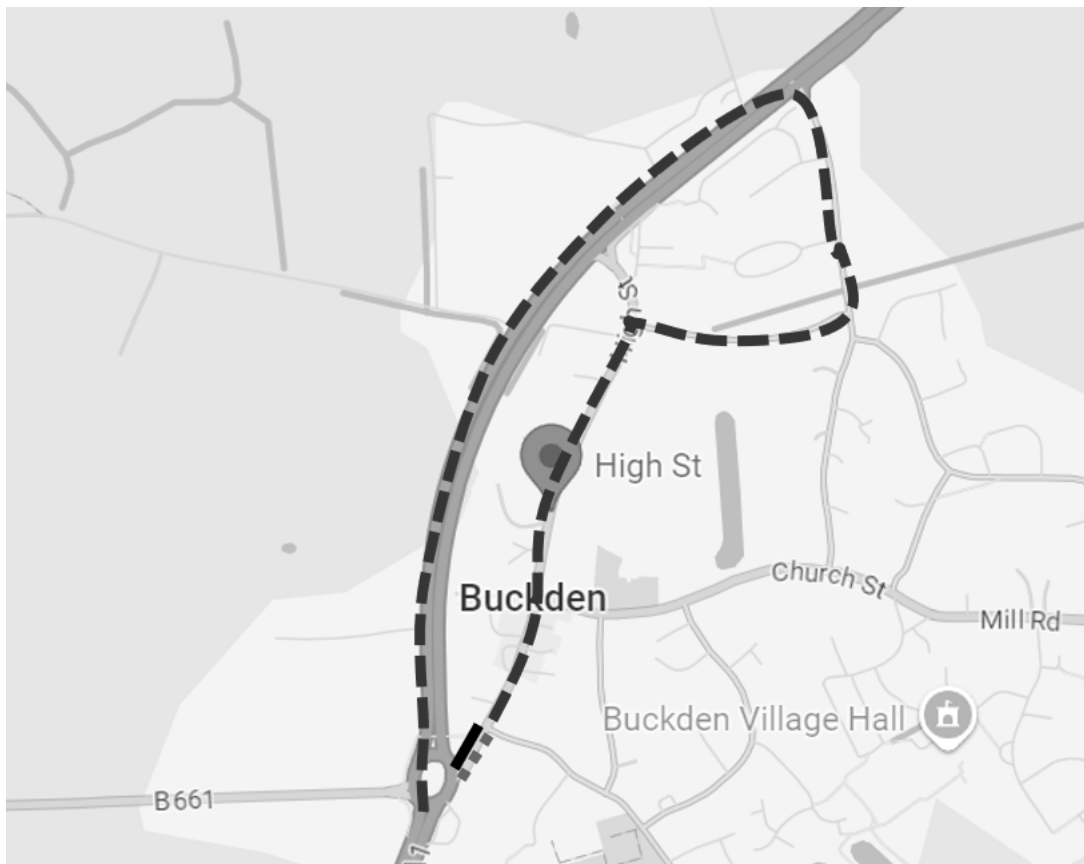

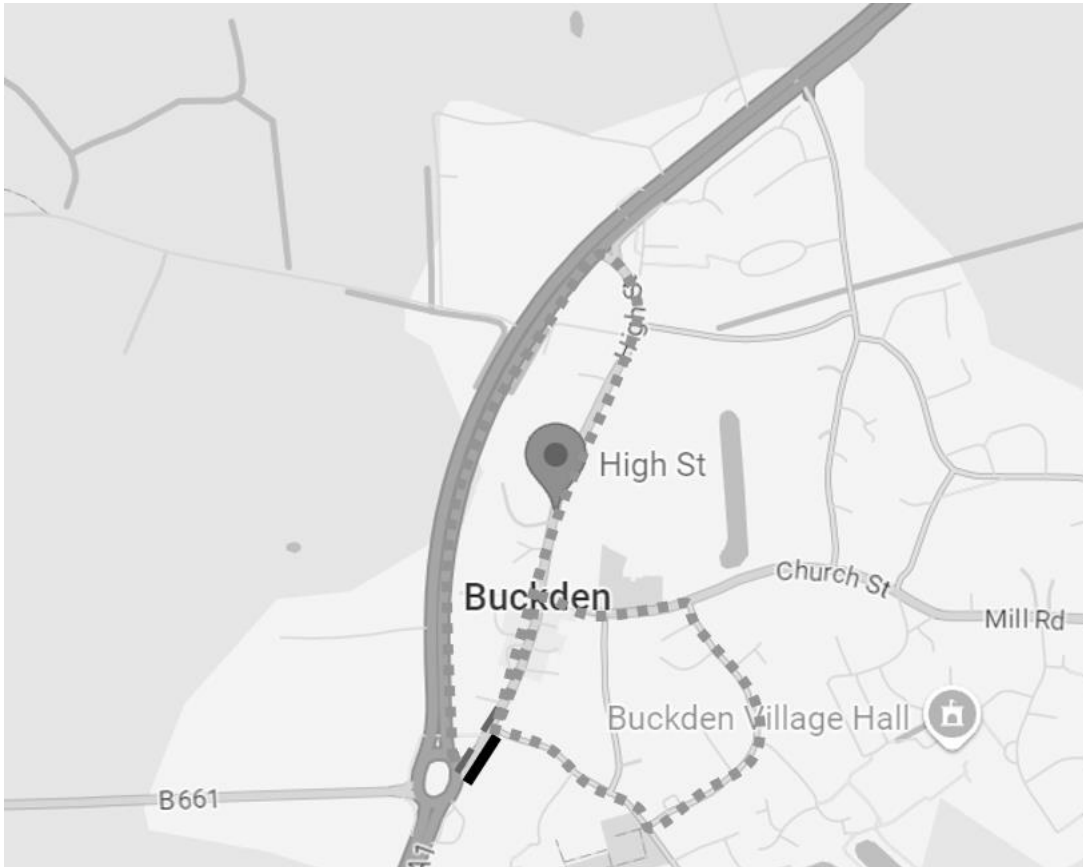
Phase 1 of the works.
