

BPC and BVHT Liaison Meeting 19th January 2026

Attendees: Peter Clark, Caroline Underwood, Des Foster & Matthew Beldam

- 1. Actions from previous meeting – Head of Terms between BPC and BVHT agreed at council meeting – to be approved at next trustees meeting 3rd Feb 2026.**
- 2. Update on Greening Project – Des commented that following a meeting with Cambridge and Peterborough Combined Authority they have agreed to extend the deadline for completion of the works to end of April 2026. Contractor (Grow) have been given authority to proceed, and works are ongoing with site surveys starting on Wednesday. Martin Rose is leading the project. External communication to the village to be agreed at the next trustees meeting 3rd Feb. CU stated that BPC have spare hedging plants – Martin to be advised if these can be incorporated.**
- 3. Update on Youth Activities– With the resignation of Andy Peckham, CU will need contact the new bar manager at the club. BPC have a Gazebo which they can move to the field when ready. Des suggest locating this on to the top pétanque pitch which is not used. MB commented there is also power to the lower pitch lights, which could be used to lighting and power to the Gazebo.**
- 4. Update from BVHT. Des advised that we have formed a small sub-committee to investigate future projects and they will bring these to the trustees for review and possible approval subject to funding. MB advised that one of the new trustees is a director of marketing and is revising the communication strategy for the trust. Michael Landers is looking for funding from the FA to refurbish the pavilion and will update trustees on progress. Des to submit our annual accounts and reports to the Charity Commission by the end of Jan.**
- 5. Updates from BPC – Both PC and CU commented that they are working closely with other councils now, a new councillor has joined. Speed limits especially in Lucks Lane, on going discussions around Brampton Hut development and the roundabout. Roundabout magazine could potentially stop due to the whole stepping down – no volunteers have come forward so far to take over the roles. Repair Café to continue which have proved very popular. Games to continue during school holidays. Diddington path development updates and holding regular meetings now with our local MP which is proving useful.**
- 6. AOB – BPC to be kept informed of SuDs project by BVHT. Playground improvement – Martin Rose to be engaged on design. Council elections to be held in May.**
