

Rights of Way and Tree Advisory Group report June 2020

Historic walk leaflet.

It has been agreed to progress a new Historic walk leaflet. Funding is from the grant for the Round-about-Buckden walk. Alec MacAndrew has taken new photos and we are going to commission Shelley signs to produce the leaflet.

Footpath signs.

We need footpath signs to indicate the new right of way along the Anglian Water road and to replace a broken one between B7 and B8. Given the nature of both situations, the signs need to be finger posts. CU will email CCC Footpath Officer re provision of signs; if they are not receptive we will have to fund them and quotes have been sought.

3 quotes acquired for 2 finger posts; 1 with 1 directional arm and 1 with 2 arms. The prices are ex VAT.
