

Highways and Cycling Update May 2021

Buckden to Brampton Cycle Path

Meeting held with CCC Cycle Team and Highways team to discuss next steps and potential use of contractor Skanska due to backlog of work. Alternative option provided by Active Travel but this would take longer to implement as it would require work on land now owned by CCC. BPC would like to proceed with the more immediate solution. Site meeting taking place on Tuesday 27th April with Caroline Underwood attending from BPC.

TTRO

Elaine sent request for TTRO for High Street to take place on Sunday 27th June. This request was sent to CCC by post on 17th March with no response. Elaine chased on Friday 23rd April for an update.

School Streets

Scheme to start on Monday 7th June from 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45 to 3.30pm. School are organising communication to parents via Parentmail and children to write letter to local residents thanking them for their understanding and co-operation on a scheme designed to help keep them safe on their way in to school. Mill Road MVAS and Signage

Proposal sent to Ramune who approved scheme for BPC. There will be two movable units as per Perry Road. Some concerns around requirement to maintain battery and move every 4 weeks. This is what is set by CCC so we may need to discuss how we implement this requirement.

Path and Road Survey

Clive completed a pothole survey. The survey results need to be logged on the CCC website. Two DofE students are due to complete a pavement survey for their volunteering requirements in the next couple of weeks.
