4. Planning:

a. Application –

The site is monitored by Cambridgeshire County Council and is fully compliant with our planning permission H/5014/17/CM.

There have been no submissions since the last liaison meeting.

b. Restoration Application

The Company is still progressing environmental information and it is hoped an application will be submitted latter half of 2022

5. Site Developments:

a. Existing quarrying update

The Quarry is still working in Area B which should be exhausted by May 2022. The conveyor system is being removed and relocated to C and D. The remaining mineral from the Haul Road is being extracted as highlighted orange below.



Area B

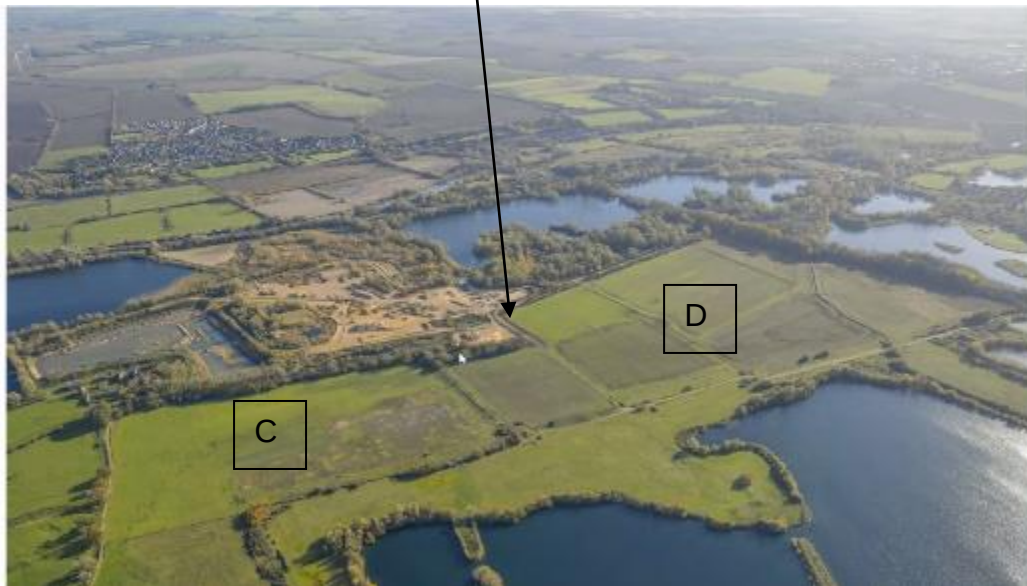
The Company continues to implement good practice regarding protected species as part of our ongoing operations.

All area of C and D have been stripped of topsoil and all field archaeological investigations have been completed. All soils are retained and stored on site for restoration.
The Company is installing the conveyor in areas C and D for commencement of extraction in May. A bridge will be installed over the conveyor along footpath 207/2.

Area C shall be worked in approximately 4 months

Area D shall be worked in approximately 2 years

Restoration requires importation of material to achieve the current scheme, further planning application to be submitted 2022.

6. Environmental Issues:

- a. Dust – No Complaints / Comments received – AI undertake dust mitigation in accordance with planning permission
- b. Noise - No Complaints / Comments received – AI undertake noise monitoring in accordance with planning permission
- c. Traffic – The Company is looking at maintenance along the haul road.
No complaints received.
Little Paxton PC - yellow lines along Great North Road to prevent parked cars/ lorries shall be implemented March 2022.
- d. Rights of Way – The Company has submitted the application to divert routes of 63.1 and 207.1. the RoW officer has been to site and has walk the route and identified the location of the way markers. The waymarkers shall be installed Spring and It is hoped the new diverted route can be opened as soon as possible. The Company will notify the Liaison Group.

With regards to the additional temporary diversion which was presented to the Liaison group relating to footpath 207/03 within Southoe and Midloe Parish. The RoW officer has reviewed our proposal and at present we have no mechanism to undertake a temporary diversion. The Company would seek to capture the proposed diversion as part of the restoration application.

e. Restoration / Biodiversity

The Company is working in accordance with the approved restoration plan and environmental management plan. The Company is hoped to have Phase 1 of the Nature Reserve completed by the June 2022. The land will then be formally handed over to Hunts DC and will see the Nature Reserve expand in a northerly direction.

Phase 2 - Diddington Pit will be completed late Summer 2022.

Restoration of A1 will be Summer 2022 once the conveyor system has been relocated to access restoration material.

7. Any Other Business

AM - Still ongoing flooding problems along the A1. Savills/ Ski Lake has cleared their ditches but Webbs still need to remove built up debris. Parish still communicating with Savills and the Lead Flood Authority to resolve the problem.
