The Climate Change Mitigation Advisory Group is working on three main events to support The National "Great Big Green Week".

The first event in support of this event week is the Buckden litter pick, being held on Sunday 19th September.

The second event is on Friday afternoon 24th September at 3pm, Being held in conjunction with Buckden C of E Infants School, in the school grounds. attended by both parents and residents, this will involve outside covered stands displaying various environmental subjects and including the BPC stand showing the good work the council is doing. Other stands proposed are, the benefits of the "Electrification of transport", "Solar panels is it right for you", "Energy saving in your home LED lighting and insulation", "Allotments, Garden wilding". We intend to, as well as creating displays and information, to have as many councillors and knowledgeable members of the public on hand to offer advise and guidance to those attending.

The Third event is Sunday 26th September, being held at Hunts End in and around the newly "wilded" triangle grasses area and will run from 2pm to 5pm. Stands will include examples of EV's from the village including Tesla, Volkswagon, BMW, Jaguar and Renault.
